

INS Kavaratti: Lessons in time, cost management

Indigenously built warfare corvette set to be commissioned

When Chief of Army General Manoj Mukund Naravane commissions Indian Naval Ship (INS) Kavaratti (pictured) at Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers, Kolkata (GRSE), it will mark the end of Project 28 — one of the Navy's most-ambitious, most-delayed, and most-budget busting warship projects.

Project 28, which envisioned building four indigenous anti-submarine corvettes, will end four years later than planned. The Ministry of Defence (MoD) approved it in 2003 and the first corvette was to be delivered in 2012, with the other three following at one-year intervals.

Project 28 has also overshot its budget by more than 250 per cent. The project's sanctioned cost was ₹2,700 crore, but will end up costing over ₹7,000 crore.

Project 28 illustrates why time and cost overruns are endemic to most Indian warship building projects. A central reason is the Navy's operational assessment that it is better to get a warship late and over-budget than to get one that is technologically overmatched by potential adversaries.

Project 28 also suffered significant delays because the Navy insisted on indigenising each corvette to the maximum extent possible. GRSE told *Business Standard* that INS Kavaratti will have

achieved an unprecedented indigenisation level of 90 per cent.

Delay began even before construction did, with the Navy deciding that Project 28 corvettes would be the first Indian warships to be constructed from indigenous warship-grade steel. The Steel Authority of India's Bhilai steel plant eventually developed the so-called DMR249A steel. But that involved a two-year delay. Then, after INS Kamorta and INS Kadmat — the first two corvettes — joined the fleet in 2014 and 2016, respectively, the Navy ambitiously decided to build the remaining two corvettes' superstructures with composite materials to make them lighter and, therefore, faster. In addition, warships built from composites reflect radar far less than steel, making them harder to detect.

This meant going to Kockums of Sweden for materials and to learn construction with composites, causing another year of delay.

On the positive side, this resulted in the weight of the third and fourth corvettes — INS Kiltan and Kavaratti — being reduced from 3,150 tonnes to just 3,000 tonnes. These corvettes now cleave through the seas at a pace 46 kilometres per hour (kmp/h) and have a patrol endurance of 6,400 km at a speed of 33 kmp/h.

Further delay was caused because of the determination to indigenise as many systems and sub-systems as possible. Vendors had to be developed even in the

complex areas of sensors and weapons, where import content is usually high.

GRSE says INS Kavaratti will field a 76 millimetre Otomelara gun built by Bharat Heavy Electricals, while Larsen & Toubro has built its heavyweight torpedo tubes and rocket launchers. Ordnance Factory, Ambarnath manufactures the Kavach chaff launchers that serve as decoys for incoming missiles. Bharat Electronics has built most of the sensors and combat management systems in INS Kavaratti.

Kirloskar Oil Engines has built the four diesel engines that power the Project 28 corvettes, while Cummins and Kirloskar Electric have engineered the 3 megawatt generators that supply electricity on board.

Remarkably, the expertise that GRSE and its sub-vendors have accumulated in designing and manufacturing a world-class anti-submarine corvette will now wither, since there are no more orders for such warships. Instead, the Navy is evolving a design for the so-called 'next-generation corvette'.

Major navies evolve a successful warship design and then achieve economy of scale by building them in large numbers, with only incremental changes to the basic design. The US Navy has built 82 destroyers of the successful Arleigh Burke-class and China is following the same approach with its latest Type 055 Rehnai-class destroyers.

Early bird results show gains from 'Unlock'

The combined net profit of 76 manufacturing and service sector companies (excluding banks and IT services exporters) was up 23.2 per cent YoY during Q2, against earnings contraction in the previous three quarters. These companies' net profit was down 41.3 per cent YoY in June 2020 quarter and by 31.4 per cent in the March quarter. Their combined net sales was up 4.5 per cent YoY during Q2 — the fastest growth in the last five quarters. In the previous two quarters, these companies had posted 23 per cent and 11.6 per cent contraction in top line, due to the lockdowns imposed to curb the spread of coronavirus.

Banks and IT services exporters were least impacted by the curbs as they were allowed to operate normally, unlike manufacturers, most of whom faced closures.

Analysts, however, remain cautious about the growth prospects of India Inc. "Earnings look good on a year-on-year basis, but volumes are still down in key sectors such as cement, indicating a tepid demand scenario in the economy. The earnings recovery has largely come from price increases and lower raw material and energy costs, which may not sustain for long," said G Chokkalingam, founder & MD, Equinomics Research.

He also cautioned investors that they should not read too much into the early bird results, given the small sample size. "A majority of companies is yet to declare

their results, and good results are declared first every quarter. It would be premature to draw any conclusion based on these numbers," he said.

There are around 5,000 listed companies in India, out of which around 3,500 are operationally active and report quarterly results. The early bird sample has 8 companies that are part of the Nifty 50 index. Cement makers and metal producers clearly show the impact of an uptick in prices of their products and fall in costs, boosting their profitability.

ACC's net sales was flat YoY, while its raw material cost was down by a quarter. Thus, its operating profit was up 17 per cent and net profit by 20 per cent YoY in the September quarter. Zinc and lead producer Hindustan Zinc showed a dichotomy between volume and profitability. In fact, metal producers such as Hindustan Zinc, Tata Steel BSL, Tata Steel Long, and Monnet Ispat topped the charts with strong double-digit growth in net sales. In contrast biggies such as HDFC Bank, Tata Consultancy Services, Infosys, HCL Technologies, Wipro, and Avenue Supermarkets either reported low single digit growth in revenue or a decline in their top line compared to the year-ago period.

Compared to the June quarter, however, HDFC Bank, Infosys, HCL Technologies, Britannia, Wipro, and L&T Infotech reported a moderation in their top line growth. Food and consumer goods makers such as Hindustan Unilever and Britannia are in the middle with high single-digit growth in net sales and double-digit growth in earnings, thanks to gains from lower costs including raw materials.

For others, however, early bird results confirm the post-Covid economic recovery.

"Most results have been on the expected line and confirms the steady improvement in economic and financial condition after a virtual shutdown in the economy during the June quarter," said Dhananjay Sinha, head of research at Systemix Institutional Equity.

This, he said, had provided support to the current rally on Dalal Street. The Nifty50 index is up 5 per cent since the beginning of this month.

Banerjee said that apart from infrastructure, health care and digital space were among the areas that had huge scope for foreign investments.

Fund managers, too, see this meeting as an opportunity to fill the gap that has been created

amid issues concerning China.

"When the prime minister of a country engages with investors, it brings serious money on the table at a lower risk premium. Investors will demand lesser premium when they get confidence... (It will also bring) other benefits like longer-term commitment, technology, and follow-through support," said Nilesh Shah, chairman of the Association of Mutual Funds in India. "India and China were of similar size in the 80s. In four decades, they have become five times bigger than us. Such engagements will help us narrow the gap with China," he added.

On a stimulus package, Bajaj said the finance minister had asked officials to explore another stimulus package and the ministry was working on it. "The government has received suggestions from various ministries and sectors on the needed measures. While preparing for the next year's Budget, we are also looking at expenditure for this year and requirements of various ministries," Bajaj said. Focusing on pension and insurance funds, the DEA secretary said it was important to engage with other regulators, as they also needed to look at supporting this market. According to him, regulatory requirements for pension funds, insurance funds, need some tinkering. "Today pension funds from Canada, Australia, Europe, and the US are showing a huge interest in investing in India. But insurance companies and pension funds are still looking at the same usual products such as bonds," he said.

He further said the government was exploring possibilities to channelise domestic savings and domestic assets in the country. There are about ₹16-trillion domestic assets which could be channelised. For instance, in the case of the Employees Provident Fund, rules should be made in a manner that it is allowed to put money in the infrastructure sector, said Bajaj.

The EPFO uses its corpus (estimated at ₹13-14 trillion in last fiscal) to earn income from investments in debt instruments and equities. Investment in equities is capped at 15 per cent. The remaining funds are invested in debt.

Bajaj said there was a lot of emphasis on the public sector policy or privatisation policy and it was expected to soon get the Union Cabinet's approval.

On expenditure estimates, Bajaj said the department had asked other departments to push expenditure that had a multiplier effect. "The Centre is trying to cajole ministries and public sector enterprises to push infra spending, and will provide more money if needed to revise estimates," he said. Further, the production-linked incentive scheme for mobile phones, pharma products, and medical equipment will be extended to seven-eight sectors. This comes after a positive response from mobile manufacturers, which shows diversification in the supply chain. Bajaj said sunrise sectors were proposed to be included in the scheme.

IAF's first female officer dies at 96

BENGALURU Wing Commander (Retd) Dr Vijayalakshmi Ramanan, the first woman commissioned officer of the Indian Air Force, has died at the age of 96. Ramanan, a recipient of Vishisht Seva Medal (VSM), died peacefully due to old age ailments on Sunday at her daughter's home here, her son-in-law S L V Narayan said. Born in February 1924, she did her MBBS and later was commissioned in the Army Medical Corps on August 22, 1955 and was seconded to the Air Force with effect from the same day.

Govt relaxes onion import norms

NEW DELHI Concerned over the rising price of onions, the Centre on Wednesday relaxed the norms for import of onions while deciding to release the crop from the buffer stock in a calibrated manner. The government has built a buffer stock of onions from the Rabi season this year. In order to moderate prices, onion from the buffer stock is being released in a calibrated manner from the second half of September to the major mandis and retail suppliers such as Safal, Kendriya Bhandar and NCCF and also to the state governments, the Centre said while adding that more will be done in the coming days.

'Roll back festival train fare hike'

NEW DELHI The Congress on Wednesday urged the Railway Ministry to roll back the increase of the train fare to the tune of 25 to 30 per cent in the 302 pair of special festival trains put into service from October 20 to November 30 to clear the festival rush. It pointed out that this is over and above the fares of the special trains, which are already higher than the fares during pre-Covid period. Its spokesman Prof. Gourav Vallabh said the government is denting the festive spirit of the common man with the fare increase.

Partial relief for WB Puja pandals

KOLKATA The Calcutta High Court on Wednesday partially eased its order which had declared Durga Puja pandals in the state as "no entry zones" in view of the COVID-19 pandemic. A bench of the High Court allowed 'dhakis' to be present outside the no-entry zone in each pandal and said that 15 persons will be allowed in smaller pandals while 60 people will be allowed for larger pandals. The court was hearing a petition over setting up of pandals during the Durga Puja. It had earlier this week directed that the Durga Puja pandals would be no-entry zones.

Rail engine seized for elephant deaths

GUWAHATI The Assam forest department on Wednesday seized the engine of a goods train for mowing down an elephant and its calf inside the Lumding Reserve forest area of the state. The engine was seized from the Bamanuidan Railway Yard under Wildlife Protection Act, 1972. This is the first time that such an action has been taken by the authorities. According to an official release, "One Railway Engine (loco engine number- 12440 WDG4) has been seized from the possession of Senior DME/Diesel/New Guwahati."

Sweet deal for J&K apple growers

NEW DELHI The Union Cabinet on Wednesday approved the farmers and the payment will be made through Direct Benefit Extension of the Market Intervention Scheme for apple procurement in Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) for the current season on the same terms and condition as last season. The National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation Limited will directly buy from the apple

Active Covid cases continue to fall; current tally 7.4L

JUST 10% IN HOSPITALS

India continues to cross significant milestones in its fight against Covid-19, with less than 10% of total 76.51 lakh infected still in hospitals. The recovery rate has climbed to 88.63% following the discharge of 61,775 patients in the past 24 hours up to Wednesday morning. The country saw 54,000 new infections in the same period.

There were 717 deaths in 24 hours raising the overall death toll to 1,15,914. This translates into 84 deaths per million population. There are still 7.40 lakh active cases of patients in hospitals, which is 8,448 less than the previous day while the recoveries totalled 67.95 lakh, with 61,775 recovering in 24 hours.

As many as 9.72 crore have been tested for the Coronavirus, 10.84 lakh of them in 24 hours.

Maharashtra still tops with 213 deaths in 24 hours, followed by 66 in Karnataka, 61 in West Bengal, 50 in Tamil Nadu and Chhattisgarh and 41 in Delhi.



Don't junk plasma therapy: Delhi min

After the India Council of Medical Research (ICMR) said that it might remove plasma therapy from COVID-19 national treatment protocol, Delhi Health Minister Satyendar Jain asked the council to not do so. "Plasma therapy has proved beneficial to more than 2000 people who have availed donations through the Delhi Governments plas-

ma bank. I, myself am a COVID-19 survivor because of plasma. Plasma therapy works and can help COVID patients get another chance at life, so ICMR shouldn't remove it. Even the US has said that it's beneficial," Jain said on Wednesday.

Gurung ditches NDA for Didi

"We have been a part of the NDA since 2009, but the BJP-led dispensation hasn't kept its promise of finding a permanent political solution for the Hills. It has not included 11 Gorkha community in the list of Scheduled Tribes. We feel cheated, so we are walking out of NDA today," Gurung said, adding that he lived in Delhi for three years after fleeing from the Hills.

Allahabad HC grants bail to scribe Kanojia

A bench of Justice A R Masoodi passed the order on the bail plea of Kanojia. The petitioner had pleaded that he was innocent and was implicated due to ulterior reasons. Kanojia was arrested by the Uttar Pradesh Police on August 18 from Delhi.

An amount of ₹ 6.63 Crores booked during the three months ended 30/09/2020 and ₹ 164.00 Crores booked during the six months ended 30/09/2020 as a one-time expense upon receiving an order dated 17/07/2020, issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court denying the Company's claim of capital investment subsidy, sanctioned in 2010 under Rajasathan Investment Promotion Scheme -2003, and one of the subsidiary of the Company has made an impairment provision of ₹ 57.92 crores towards old advances for purchase of certain land wherein the Company has reassessed its ability to recover such advances and impairment provision of ₹ 271.18 crores which has been made on a loan receivable (asset held for sale) based on management's estimate of realizable value for the period ended 30/09/2020.
For Discontinued operations- Exceptional Items comprise :
During the period, UltraTech Nathdwara Cement Limited ("UNCL") through its subsidiary, Krishna Holdings Pte. Ltd. ("Krishna"), a company incorporated in Singapore has completed the divestment of its entire equity shareholding of 92.5% in its cement subsidiary at a net consideration of USD 94.70 Mn. Further, in respect of another step down subsidiary of UNCL which is held for sale, the Company has evaluated the carrying value based on an independent valuation report and recorded a net gain of ₹ 359.87 crores on sale/remeasurement of discontinued operations.
All the above items put together constitute an exceptional gain (net) of ₹ 24.14 crores during the three months ended 30/09/2020 and exceptional loss (net) of ₹ 133.23 crores during the six months ended 30/09/2020.
- The Government of India, on 20/09/2019, vide the Taxation Laws (Amendment) Ordinance 2019, inserted a new Section 115BAA in the Income Tax Act, 1961, which provides an option to the Company for paying Income Tax at reduced rates as per the provisions/conditions defined in the said section. The Company is continuing to provide for income tax at the old rates, based on the available outstanding MAT credit entitlement and various exemptions and deductions available to the Company under the Income Tax Act, 1961. However, the Company had applied the lower income tax rates on the deferred tax assets' liabilities to the extent these were expected to be realised or settled in the future period when the Company may be subjected to lower tax rate and accordingly reversed net deferred tax liability of ₹ 2,109.46 Crores during the year ended 31/03/2020.

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मराठी पदार्थाना 'ग्लोबल' करणारी सुगरण

कोणताही असल मराठीमोळा पदार्थ करायचा झाला तर आपण हमखास युट्यूबवर जाऊन तो पदार्थ कसा करायचा हे शोधतो. आणि हा शोध घेत असताना मधुरा रेंसिपी हे यूट्यूब चॅनेल येते आणि क्षणाचा विचारही न करता आपण त्यावर क्लिक करून तो पदार्थ कसा तयार करायचा हे बघू लागतो. तमाम खवय्यांमध्ये मां ते अगदी लहान असो वा थोर सर्वांमध्ये मधुरा रेंसिपी आणि ते सादर करणा-या मधुरा बाचल हे नाव लोकप्रिय झाले आहे. यशस्वी बँकर, त्यानंतर एक गृहिणी ते एक यशस्वी ब्लॉगर असा मधुरा यांचा प्रवास खरोखरच थक करणारा आणि प्रेरणा देणारा आहे.



भारतात परतल्यानंतर मधुरा आणि त्यांचे कुटुंब पुण्यात स्थायिक झाले. आणि पुन्हा एकदा मराठी पदार्थ लोकप्रिय करण्याचा ध्यास घेत २०१६ मध्ये मधुरा रेंसिपी मराठीत सुरू केलं. (त्याआधी हिंदी भाषेतही चॅनेल सुरू झालं होतं) चॅनेल सुरू झाल्यानंतर दीड वर्षांतच १० लाख सबस्क्राइबर झाले (आजमितीला या चॅनेलचे ३७ लाखांहून अधिक सबस्क्राइबर आहेत.). असं करणारं मधुरा रेंसिपी मराठी हे पहिलं चॅनेल होतं. मधुरा यांच्यासाठी हे नक्कीच अभिमानाची बाब होती. परंतु लाईक, सबस्क्राइबर या चौकटीत त्यांना स्वतःला बांधून घ्यायचे नव्हते. त्याही पलीकडे जाऊन जागतिक पातळीवर मराठी पदार्थ लोकप्रिय करण्यासाठी काय कराता येईल याचा सातत्यानं विचार सुरू होता. त्यातूनच मग गोडा मसाला, कांदा लसूण मसाला, बेडगी मिरची तिखट हे असलेले मराठोळे मसाले विकण्याचा विचार पुढे आला. याबद्दल मधुरा सांगतात, जेव्हा मसाले विकणार असल्याची घोषणा केली. त्याच दिवशी संघाकाळापर्यंत दीड हजार मसाल्यांची पाकिटे विकली गेली. हे आमच्यासाठी नक्कीच आनंदाचं होतं. असं करणारा हा एकमेव ब्रँड होता आणि तो मराठी असल्याचा अभिमान होता.

अर्थात त्यांचा हा प्रवास नक्कीच सोपा नव्हता. मधुरा मूळ पुण्याच्या. तिचं बालपण अतिशय खडतर असं होतं. शिकण्याची जिद होती. त्यामुळे तिच्या पालक झाल्यानंतर त्यांनी विज्ञान शाखेत त्यांनी प्रवेश घेतला. त्यांना रिसर्चमध्ये करिअर करायचं होतं. परंतु घराची परिस्थिती अधिकच विकट झाल्यानं बारावीनंतर त्यांना नोकरी करावी लागली. मग नाईलाजाने वाणिज्य शाखेत प्रवेश घ्यावा लागला. सकाळी कॉलेजला जाऊन नऊ वाजेपर्यंत जितकी जमतील तितकी लेक्चर बसायचं आणि त्यानंतर ऑफिसला जायचं. मग संघाकाळी मॅटी, रंगोळी शिकवण्याचे क्लासेस त्या घ्यायच्या आणि रात्री उशिरानं घरी परतायच्या. त्यानंतर मग अभ्यास. असा त्यांचा दिनक्रम झाला होता. कालांतरानं त्यांचं इंजिनियरिंग असलेल्या मोगेशा बाचल यांच्याशी लग्न झालं आणि त्या अमेरिकेला स्थायिक झाल्या. तिथे गेल्यानंतर मधुरा बँकेत काम करत होत्या. लहानपण कष्टात गेल्यानंतर आता मधुरा यांच्या आयुष्याला स्वैर्य मिळालं होतं... २००६ मध्ये मधुरा आणि मोगेशा यांना मुलगी झाली. तिच्या संगोपनामध्ये काही वेळ गेला. या काळात त्यांच्यातील सुगुण गृहिणी पुन्हा सजा झाल्यानं वेगवेगळे पदार्थ युट्यूबवर शोधू करू लागल्या. हा शोध घेत असताना मराठोळे पदार्थ मात्र त्यांना सापडत नव्हते. मग आपणच हे का करू नये असा विचार मधुरा यांच्या मनात आला. हा विचार त्यांनी मोगेशा यांना सांगितल्यावर तुला हे जमणार का? परंतु मधुरा यांचा

निश्चय बघून त्यांनी पाठिंबा देत मदत करण्याची तयारी दर्शवली. याबाबत मधुरा सांगतात, 'कोणतीही गोष्ट करायची ठरवली की अचानकपणे होत नाही. त्यासाठी एक ध्येय ठरवावे लागतं, त्यासाठी फॅशन असावं लागतं. तरच तुमचं ध्येय साध्य होतं. मग सुखवस्तू अशा नोकरीचा राजीनामा देत आणि मराठी पदार्थ जागतिक पातळीवर नेण्याचं उद्दिष्ट्य ठेवत २००९ मध्ये मधुरा रेंसिपी हे पहिलं व्हॉल्यूम चॅनेल सुरू केलं. सहा महिन्यांत शंभर रेंसिपीचे व्हॉडिओ शूट करून अपलोड केले. त्यानंतर हे व्हॉडिओ पाहिले जाऊ लागले दोन वर्षे हे सगळं सुरू होतं. याच दरम्यान स्वतःची वेबसाईट सुरू झाली होती. मधुरा रेंसिपी युट्यूब चॅनेल सुरू झाल्यानंतर भारतामधील पहिल्या चार लोकप्रिय चॅनेलमध्ये त्यांचा समावेश होता. जवळपास ५० लाक त्यांचे सबस्क्राइबर होते. हे सारं सुरू असताना २०१४ मध्ये मधुरा आणि तिच्या मिस्टरांनी भारतात परतण्याचा निर्णय घेतला.
